Gender inequality remains a major barrier to human and community development worldwide. Across Africa and Asia, women and girls are consistently denied access to equivalent opportunities their male counterparts receive, and are often prevented from accessing education, engaging equally in society, or participating in sports activities. *Sport* has the powerful ability to reduce restrictions in society, and provides a unique environment where harmful gender norms can be renegotiated. Research shows that sport for development programs, like KPI, are effective at empowering girls and developing supportive young boys.

In addition to the typical poverty-related challenges, community members bear varying degrees of intergenerational trauma from the genocide, and many lack healthy coping mechanisms. Violence against women abounds, and the community does not view girls as successful students, community leaders, or professionals.
