WATER FILTRATION SYSTEM INVESTOR

Build and provide access to clean water immediately in either our Rwanda or Cambodia program site. A lack of access to water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) affects women and girls disproportionally, due both to biological and cultural factors. In addition to meeting girls/women's needs around menstrual and sexual and reproductive health, WASH is also essential for their social and economic development, contributing towards gender equality and the realization of their rights. \$15,000 / Program Site

WASH ADVOCATE

Provide Water and Sanitation Hygiene sessions to KPI Families and children to promote healthy behaviors such as hand washing, reduced spread of viruses and disease, proper menstrual hygiene management (MHM), sexual reproductive health (SRH) and family planning. Raise awareness about MHM and SRH among school-age girls <u>and</u> boys to dispel myths and reduce fear and discrimination.
