




What Inspired PLAY FAIR?

HISTORY

Since 2010 Kids Play International, a non profit founded by 3x Olympian Tracy Evans, has provided *successful* year round gender equity programs to youth and adults using lesser known sports, the Olympic values and our 5 PlayFair skills to break the intergenerational cycle of systemic gender discrimination, inequality and violence -in the post genocide affected countries of Rwanda and Cambodia.

Kids Play has seen first hand how by having people understand that everything they say, do and believe impacts the people around them and molds the culture on the field, at work, in their homes, classrooms and throughout their communities.

WHAT IS OPLAY FAIR

ABOUT: Kids Play has adapted their <u>proven</u> gender equity, sports-based programming and methodology from Rwanda and Cambodia into a relevant training for the US. *PlayFair* training builds competencies in 5 *PlayFair* areas/skills: 1) Respect; 2) Community; 3) Contribution; 4) Opportunity; and, 5) Moral Courage. The *PlayFair* Training provides a framework for people (coaches, staff, players) to foster positive culture and connections where they play, work, and live.

WHO: *PlayFair* can be geared for various groups of people: corporate, coaches and athletes, peer mentors, and even parents of youth athletes.

How we build Culture and Connection

PlayFair employs an applied and sport-based approach to build competencies in **5 core areas**:



Respect

Listen, show appreciation, acceptance and inclusion: ask first, know their story, support equal opportunities



Provides protection, support, friendship, belonging: join in activities, invite others to join, ask for assistance



Helps achieve a positive result for our team, family, and community: discover your strengths, celebrate others strengths, offer to help



Risks we choose to take that can result in growth and learning: build a positive culture, practice taking risks, promote perseverance

Moral Courage

Standing up for what and who you believe in even when it is hard: choose to care, speak up, take action

The Power of PLAY FAIR APPLIED LEARNING

Applied learning refers to an educational approach whereby participants learn by engaging in direct application of skills, discussions, theories and models.

Participants **PRACTICE** *PlayFair* skills through sport drills, dialoguing and role play. Continued honing of these skills will shift participants mindsets and actions in their work and everyday activities.

PlayFair provides participants with tangible techniques and tools for ongoing practice and adoption at work, on the playing field, home and in life.

What is the VALUE of PlayFair Training?

- Connected Teams make decisions 2X faster (Forbes)
- Creating an intentionally inclusive framework (culture) creates
 a safe and open sport or work environment. (American
 Psychological Assoc.)
- Diverse management leads to 19%+ increase to companies bottom lines (Boston Consulting Group)
- \$12 trillion could be added to global GDP by 2025 if the gender gap is narrowed (McKinsey Global Institute)
